

Board Of Directors — Independent Tertiary Education Council Australia

The [Independent Tertiary Education Council Australia](#) (ITECA) is undertaking an extensive review of its governance infrastructure. This reflects the proactive role of the ITECA Board in ensuring that they operate within the context of contemporary corporate governance principles for membership-based organisations.

At the 2019 annual general meeting the ITECA Board will take on a new structure to reflect the organisation's peak status representing the independent tertiary education system encompassing the higher education, vocational education and training sectors. The ITECA Board will include representatives elected by the members augmented by skills-appointed Directors.

The structure of the ITECA Board following the 2019 annual general meeting will be as follows:

ITECA Executive —

- Independent Chair
- Deputy Chair, Higher education
- Deputy Chair, Vocational education and training

ITECA Executive —

- Three directors elected by the members
- Three skills-based appointed directors

Consistent with a contemporary approach to corporate governance as recommended by the Australian Institute of Company Directors (AICD), a primary responsibility for the ITECA Board is on ensuring the organisation develops and implements strategies and supporting policies to enable it to fulfil the objectives set out in the ITECA Constitution.

The ITECA Board delegates the day to day management of the organisation but remains accountable to the shareholders for the organisation's performance. The ITECA Board monitors and supports management in an on-going way.
